# Horse Shoe Holiday Craft



## Supplies:

- Horse Shoes
- Leather Lace
- Mod Podge
- Adhesive that works on metal
- Ribbon
- Seasonal garland/decorations

## Instructions

1. Clean shoes if using repurposed shoes (soak in white vinegar for a few minutes & scrub)
2. Tie a knot with leather lace through nail hole and loop and tie on other side to create a hanger; dip each knot in mod podge to secure. Once dried use metal adhesive (or mod podge) to glue leather lace to back of shoe to ensure an even hang.
3. Arrange decorative pieces as you wish along the shoe (one side as shown or get creative and make your own design!) Glue down to shoe.
4. Attach bow and other decorative items as you wish. You can add a horse's name tag, barn name, etc to personalize!
5. Voila! You can hang in your tree, around the barn, or gift to a friend!
