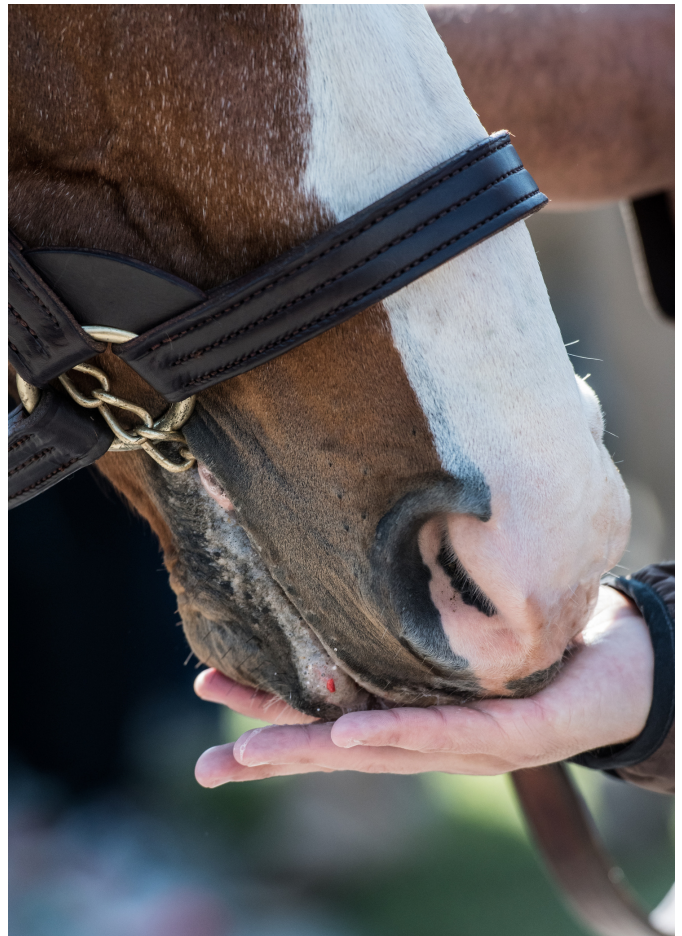

A Treat For My Sweet Recipe

Molasses Carrot Oat

Ingredients:

- 1 Flour
- 1 Cup Rolled Oats
- 1/2 Cup Shredded/Grated Carrots
- 1/3 Cup Molasses



Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F
2. Spray cookie sheet with non-stick cooking spray
3. Mix all ingredients together thoroughly.
4. Roll teaspoon-sized balls and place on cookie sheet (about 1" apart)
5. Bake 10 minutes, until hardened. Let cool and store in air-tight container.
