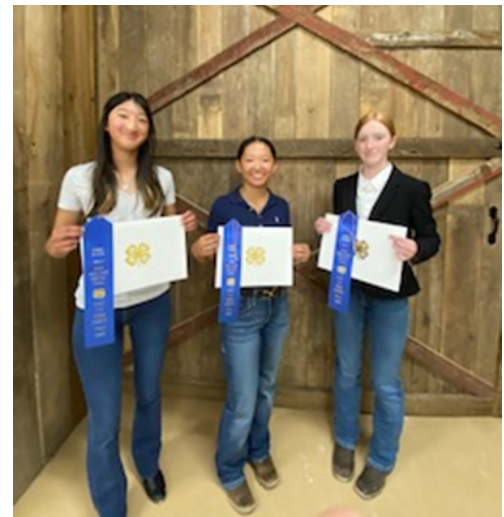
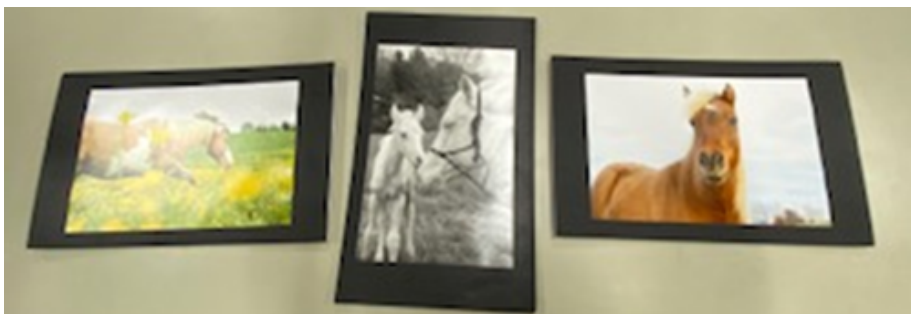
RYLIE
